

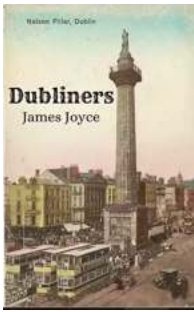

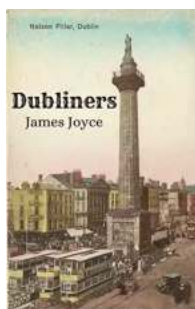

It's also notable as a portrait of middle- and working-class life in Ireland during a complicated period, when the country

was struggling towards independence from England and its citizens were searching for a uniquely Irish identity.

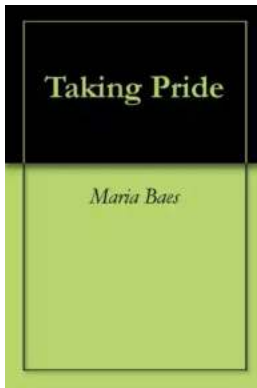

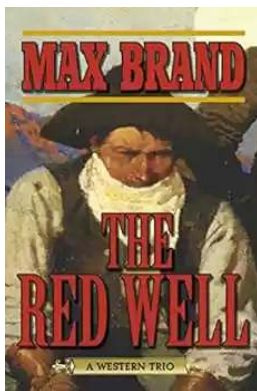
