Her view on literature had taken some time to coalesce but with the publication of parts of "Scenes From A Clerical Life" in 1858 she knew she wanted to be a novelist and as her 1856 titled essay "Silly Novels by Lady Novelists" stated not a 'silly woman's one at that. Success of course meant that her real name came out but it seemed not to affect how the public
